What is hosted VOIP?

VOIP is simply a means of transmitting phone calls and services across the internet. In terms of basic usage and functionality, a VOIP enabled telephone works exactly like a 'normal' one. However, as detailed below, VOIP has a number of other complementary features.

VOIP numbers are virtual numbers:

1. Redirect them to any other landline or mobile number
2. Use Internet-enabled phones or free-to-download PC software over the internet
3. Use one of our UMO SIM cards in a 3G phone to make your landline truly mobile **
4. Use a smart phone App on iPhone and Android to use VoIP on the go **

With hosted VOIP, Usomo manages and delivers these features to you allowing access to a far wider range of services than would typically be available without considerable investment – such as a on-premise PBX server, line rental and installation charges. Usomo's free and inclusive Hosted PBX manages your call flow. It works like a normal phone system, but at a fraction of the price.



You can access the solution from anywhere, and people who don't have VOIP themselves can still contact you via mobiles, landlines, Skype or any other VOIP service.

What is Mobile VOIP?

Mobile VoIP is your VoIP landline in a 3G mobile phone. It's our term for describing it; other terms you may come across are "Unified Communications" or "UC", and "Fixed Mobile Convergence" or "FMC" to name but two. Usomo Mobile VoIP means your landline number is truly mobile. It retains all of the features and benefits of our core VoIP product but means you can now pop your landline number in your pocket and take it with you.

How does it work?

When you sign up for Usomo Mobile VoIP or add Mobile VoIP to your existing VoIP account :

1. We send you one of our preconfigured UMO SIM cards
2. You activate it on our website
3. You pop it into an unlocked 3G mobile phone or one that works with the Hutchinson 3G operator
4. Hey presto! You have your landline number on your mobile.

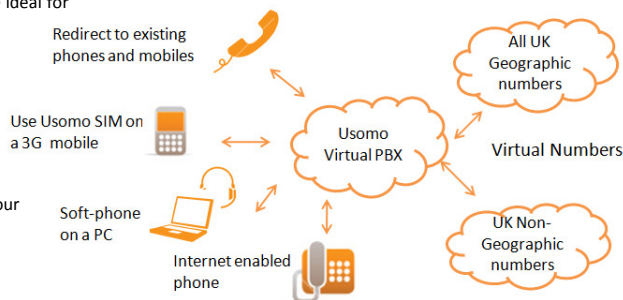
